## GUIDELINES FOR ADMITTING CHURCHES INTO FELLOWSHIP WITH THE ST. LOUIS METRO BAPTIST ASSOCIATION

Congregations desiring to affiliate with the Association must submit a **PETITION TO AFFILIATE FORM to the** Executive Committee through the Executive Director at the Association address: 3859 Fee Fee Road, Bridgeton, MO 63044. The Executive Committee will be charged to investigate the doctrine and practices of the church. The Executive Committee may visit the church, or invite the Pastor and/or Officers of the church to meet with the Executive Committee. The Executive Committee will make a recommendation concerning any church desiring to affiliate with the Association to the Executive Board and the Executive Board, will then make the recommendation to the Association meeting in Annual Session.

The Executive Committee will give consideration under the following guidelines. Each petition will be considered on its merit and evidence of the church's good will toward the Association.

- 1. Consideration will be given to congregations that have constituted as a church and incorporated according to the laws and regulations of the State of Missouri.
- 2. Churches applying for fellowship into the Association will have adopted a constitution and bylaws and submitted a copy of the same with petitionary letter.
- 3. Churches applying for fellowship must submit a completed petitionary letter with supporting documents no later than June 1 of the year they desire to be considered.
- 4. Churches applying for fellowship must agree to cooperate on the basis of the Constitution and Bylaws of the St. Louis Metro Baptist Association,
- 5. The church should demonstrate its willingness to cooperate with the Association prior to being considered by attending meetings of the Association and contributing a portion of their budget income to the unified budget of the Association. (Voluntary contributions to the Association do not automatically mean the church will be admitted into Fellowship. All funds contributed will be used in the cooperative missionary endeavors of the Association and will not be returned to the church under any circumstances).
- 6. The church should give evidence that it is in essential doctrinal agreement with the Association in its understanding of the *Baptist Faith and Message 2000*.
- 7. Congregations that have been started as a plant of a church cooperating with the Association, or as a combined effort of the Association and other Southern Baptist churches, should seek endorsement of their petition by the sponsoring church.
- 8. The church is expected to be in good standing with other churches in the St. Louis Metro Baptist Association. If the church emerged from a conflict with one or more congregations, evidence should be given that every attempt has been made for sincere reconciliation with the offended or offending congregations. The Executive Committee reserves the right to evaluate the evidence and recommend approval or disapproval of the application for affiliation on that basis.
